Dr. Rod Oglesby is a long time resident of southwest Missouri. He received a BSBA from University of Missouri - Columbia, his MBA from Southern Illinois University in Edwardsville Illinois, a Ph.D. from the University of Missouri - Columbia and completed the Institute for Educational Management program at Harvard University in Cambridge Massachusetts.

Dr. Oglesby has held many financial and administrative positions including: Controller, Director of Financial Affairs, Vice President for Financial Affairs, Executive Vice President for Internal Affairs, Chief Operating Officer – Interim CEO, Assistant Dean and Director of Graduate Study and Chief Administrative Officer of SIFE. Additionally, his faculty experience includes Instructor of Accounting, Business and Economics at Missouri Baptist College, Special Instructor of Accounting and trainer for the Management Development Institute at Missouri State University, Professor of Accounting and Management at Southwest Baptist University and is currently Professor of Accounting at Drury University in Springfield, Missouri.

An accomplished author he has published several articles in Activity Based Costing, Ethical Issues and Moral Reasoning, is currently researching the Ethics of Tax evasion. He has led numerous regional seminars, is a licensed CPA sitting on the MSCPA Ethics Committee and serves as lead Consultant with Mentor Group, LLC. Additionally, Dr. Oglesby is Editor of the Business Research Yearbook published by the International Academy of Business Disciplines and serves on the Editorial Board of the Journal of International Business Disciplines.

IFRS vs. GAAP

Dr. Rod Oglesby will present International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS) vs. Generally Accepted Accounting Principles (GAAP). Convergence is a high priority on the agendas of both the US Financial Accounting Standards Board (FASB) and the International Accounting Standards Board (IASB) and “convergence” is a term that suggests an elimination or coming together of differences. Yet much is still made of the many differences that exist between US GAAP as promulgated by the FASB and the IFRS as promulgated by the IASB, suggesting that the two GAAPs continue to be worlds apart. This apparent contradiction has prompted many questions.

Hear Dr. Oglesby address many of these issues. The history of IFRS, the current status of IFRS in the US, milestones and possible dates of required adoption. He will also answer what should you be doing? What will happen to FASB? Where are we now in the convergence plan? Don't miss this fascinating topic and it's certain impact on accounting professionals.

Business Ethics

Dr. Rod Oglesby will present Business Ethics. He will review the evolution of accounting ethics, codes of conduct for AGA, ICMA, AICPA, etc. He will address ethical analysis, the accountant's core values, the cause and consequences of unethical behavior as well as cases and examples.
